BEACH RULES - (PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100 feet of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11pm
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.

You can report illegal activity at state boat launches and boating violations to DEP Law Enforcement by calling:

860-424-3333

Include the following information in your report:

- ◆ Location, time, date and nature of the violation or suspicious activity.
- ◆ Description of boat or vehicle involved: registration or license plate number, color, make, model, etc.
- ◆ Direction of travel of the boat or vehicle.
- ◆ Description of suspect(s): note clothing and distinguishing features.
