BEACH RULES - (PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof ("swimmie") diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100 feet of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11pm
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.

TRASH & RECYCLING

Twice-a-week pick-up will continue through Tuesday, September 6th. Please follow your recycling schedule for your household trash and recyclables on Fridays (August 28th is plastics) and put out the balance of your sorted recyclables along with your weekend trash on Mondays. Containers must not exceed thirty five (35) gallons.



We must recycle (at home and at the beach too):

- 1.) Metal and glass, food and beverage containers (rinsed)
- 2.) #1 and #2 plastic beverage containers (rinsed); lids & caps go in trash
- 3.) newspaper, tied & placed in paper bags; magazines and books are also accepted
- 4.) cardboard
