When possible try and stop the incidents that you see taking place: take a picture of the person(s) involved or the license plate on their vehicle and report the incident to the police so that offenders will be arrested. The board continues to work on other security measures to address this issue.



Please take your chairs, towels and any other belongings back to your cottages at the end of the day at the beach. Also please do not hang your towels overnight on the 3rd beach fence. It should not be used as a public clothes line.

Finally, a note about parking in handicapped spots. If you do not have a designated license plate or valid placard, please DO NOT park in spots reserved for the handicapped.

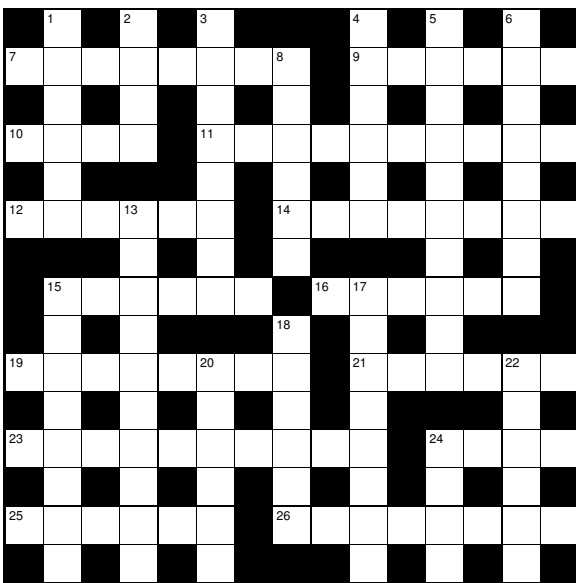

BEACH RULES - (PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof ("swimmie") diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100 feet of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11pm.
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of. Glass containers are prohibited on Association property.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.

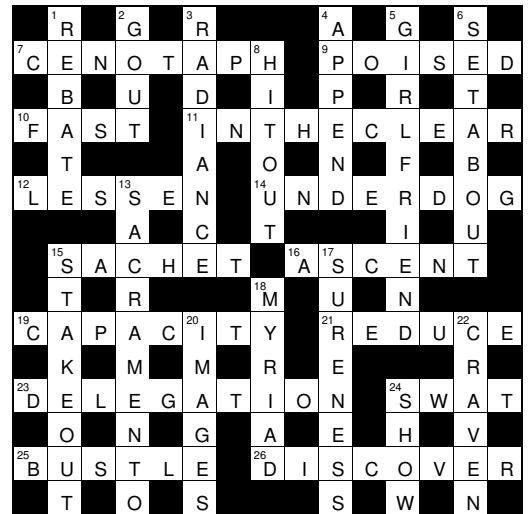
