In response to some questions regarding single-stream recycling and trash pick up, please read the following. All Waste will pick up recyclables weekly. Bottles, cans, plastic, newspapers and cardboard may be piled into the same container. All other trash must be bagged separately and if you are leaving trash on the curbside for more than one day, please put it into a covered trash can to avoid rips and trash in the road.

Security update

We have had reports of some attempted break-ins around the lake this week and boats that have been vandalized. Please be sure you take appropriate measures to secure your property. Motion-detector lighting prevented one break in. Dave Glazier has escalated patrols in the area; however, we are still trying to get our neighborhood watch

As of this reading, the security system at the pavilion is installed and operational. Parents should remind their kids that the pavilion and surrounding area is under constant surveillance with motion lights in place.

BEACH RULES - (PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof ("swimmie") diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100 feet of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11pm.
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of. Glass containers are prohibited on Association property.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.
10. Cars parking in a beach parking area must display a POALH parking sticker or a guest pass.
