TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

We have just completed negotiation of a new 2 year contract with All-Waste Control for garbage pick up through June 30th, 2010. One of the stipulations of the contract is that no garbage containers shall exceed thirty-five (35) gallons. It is important that everyone follows this rule. All-Waste trucks do not have lifting arms to hoist up the containers. They must be lifted by hand and dumped into the truck, Needless to say these new very large containers are too heavy for the guys to handle. Please think about Chris and Ed's aching back when you put out your trash. With this new contract, they will be within their rights to refuse to empty any container that exceed the 35 gallon limit.

A reminder to all that twice a week pick up (Monday and Friday) will begin on July 7th and continue thru Labor Day. Please follow your recycle schedule for the Friday pick up. The balance of your recyclables can be sorted and put out for the Monday pick up each week. If there are any questions, please call Alice Miles at 537-3611.

BEACH RULES -(THEY APPLY TO EVERYONE!!!)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100ft. of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11 PM.
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.
10. Cars parking in a beach parking area must display a POALH parking sticker or a guest pass.
