IMPORTANT NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

A large fishing boat with a gasoline motor attached was recently photographed trailing a large gasoline slick in the water. The motor was in the raised position but was obviously leaking gasoline. Research of DEP regulations by Ray Mino of East Shore Drive revealed that the state has two different regulations governing gasoline engines on boats in lakes which prohibit their use, One allows these engines to be attached and the second requires that they be removed before a boat is launched into the lake. A petition has been started which requests that the DEP change the regulation in the CT Boaters Guide which applies to Lake Hayward, The new regulation would read "Vessels with internal combustion engines attached are prohibited. Electric motors only."

Sandy Zawistowski will be at the pavilion on Saturday, July 26th from 10:00 to 11:30 AM with the petition if you wish to sign. Alice Miles will be there on Sunday, July 27th also from 10:00 to 11:30 AM. If we can get the DEP to make this change, both pollution and invasive weeds deposited into our lake would be greatly decreased.

East Haddam Referendum

The East Haddam Town Hall has confirmed a referendum for Tuesday August 5, 2008 at the Old Town Hall to vote on the town budget. POALH members owning more than \$1000.-in East Haddam Real Estate are eligible to vote. A valid driver's license is required for voting.

RECIPE OF THE WEEK

GRILLED TURKEY BURGERS

Ingredients:

1 cup chopped scallion (about 1 bunch)
3 large garlic cloves, minced
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
2 tablespoons drained capers, minced
4 1/2 pounds ground turkey

Accompaniments:

tomato ketchup
assorted mustards
12 onion rolls or hamburger buns

Preparation:

In a large bowl stir together scallion, garlic, Worcestershire sauce, capers, and salt and pepper to taste. Add turkey, combining mixture well, and form into twelve 1-inch-thick patties. Burgers may be prepared up to this point 1 day ahead and chilled, covered.

Prepare grill.

Grill burgers on an oiled rack set 5 to 6 inches over glowing coals 6 minutes on each side, or until cooked through. Serve burgers with ketchup and mustards on bread.
