TENNIS COURT USE REMINDER

Parents: Please remind your children that the tennis courts are to be used only for tennis. They should not use the courts for any other activity.

Everyone should monitor use of the tennis courts as you do other areas around the lake. If you see unacceptable behavior or activities, please politely ask the "offending persons" to stop.

BEACH RULES -(PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100ft. of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11 PM.
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.
10. Cars parking in a beach parking area must display a POALH parking sticker or a guest pass.
