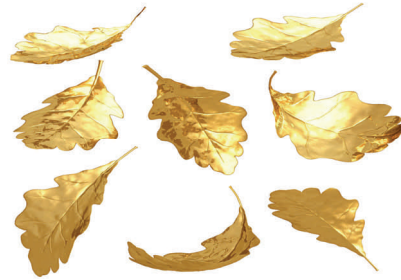

WEED TREATMENT UPDATE

PLAN B - Final Weed Treatment Changed to Monday August 25

The date for the final weed treatment of the lake was changed from Thursday August 21 to Monday August 25 in recognition of all the *Lake Hayward Days* activities.

Everything else remains the same.

Upon inspection there are still patches of fanwort weed 'hanging on' in both the north and south ends of the lake. It is recommended that we do this final treatment to maximize the impact of our treatment program this summer.

There will be a boat with a gasoline engine operating on the lake on Thursday and the use of the boat is part of the treatment permit issued by CT DEP.

The signs will be posted at each of the beaches recommending that recreational use of the lake for swimming or fishing be avoided on the day of the treatment.
