June Meeting

Update on First Beach

Clearly there has been dramatic changes made and the place looks great. That said, all the rain in the last several months has put the project about a month behind schedule. Key elements to finish up include painting the tennis courts, painting the parking areas on the parking lot, and the final installation of the lights.

There are a couple of folks that deserve special recognition and they are Andy Lord and John Jacoby. Andy was instrumental in the research and design portion of the project last fall and John has been our project foreman through all phases of the reconstruction starting last fall. He was the 'hands-on' guy who worked closely with the general contractor Chris Anelli and kept Chris's feet to the fire. We would not be where we are today without their commitment and dedication to this effort.

Obviously the end game is to get the tennis courts fully functional as soon as possible and we are working closely to work with the painting crew to complete their task soon.

Public Safety

A new walkway has been built to assist folks using the Third Beach parking lot. Steps have been added to get out of the parking area and the new walkway eliminates the need for people to walk in the road to get the beach area.

As part of the First Beach Renovation, the porta-potties have been relocated behind the pavilion. This eliminates the need to people, and particularly the little ones, from having to cross the street to perform this important duty. The port-potties will be fenced off to make them as discrete as possible.
