Message from the President ~ Tim Pelton

If you had a chance to get out on the water you'd see that the lake is unusually clear for this time of year and that is a great opportunity for a few reminders that helps to preserve our beautiful lake.

It is important to recognize and appreciate that the association is built on a 'bowl' that surrounds the west side of the lake. Everything that goes down the drain or fertilizers we use in the garden or on our lawns will eventually wind up in the lake.

Here are some common sense thoughts for all of us to consider:

- Pump your septic tank every 2-3 years
- Local septic tank companies include: Redi-Rooter 860-267-2563, Signore Services 860-859-2319, Vaill Septic 860-537-6411.
- Never discharge 'grey' water from the washing machine or dishwasher directly onto the lawn
- If you feel the need to use a fertilizer, please use it sparingly
- Organic fertilizers are better than chemically based fertilizers high in phosphate and nitrates
- Using a commercial lawn fertilizer service is discouraged
- Try to use dish soap and hand soap low in phosphates
- Do not feed the geese and discourage them from hanging around

If everyone does their part, we will continue to keep our lake pristine and beautiful.

As an additional reminder, fishing and boating is strictly prohibited from all of the swimming areas and dogs are not allowed (leashed or otherwise) on any of the beaches.

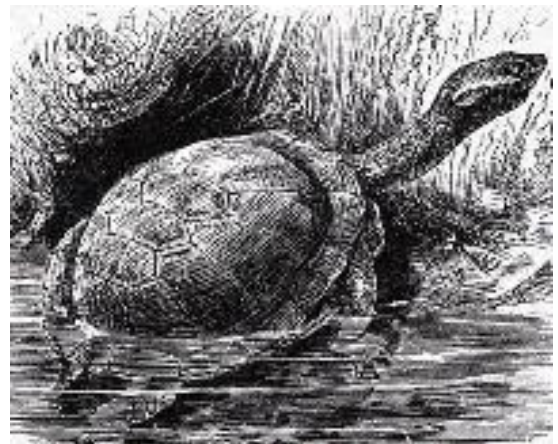
Lake Hayward Storybook that will be published in August in honor of the 50th anniversary celebration. She would love to hear tidbits or stories from the early days of the lake!
