Boating Safety

I'd like to take a moment and simply refresh everyone's' memory on some common sense boating safety rules provided by CT DEP and special attention is needed for both adults and children in kayaks and canoes.

- Proper personal floating devices (PDF) must be Coast Guard approved
- Children under 12 years of age need to wear a PDF...period.
- PDFs are not meant to be boat fenders or seat cushions
- CT Law requires that everyone wear a PDF from the period October 1 through May 30
- 85% of boating related drowning accidents could be prevented if people wore a PDF

Most folks won't dream of taking their children for a drive and not having them wear their seat belt. Let's use that same mentality with children and PDFs.

A Word On walking, biking, rollerblading and skateboarding (particularly at night)

When using roads around the lake please appreciate that you share the road with automobiles. Many folks using Lake Shore Drive may not be familiar that it is a beach road with high pedestrian traffic. Do NOT assume that the driver sees you and use common sense when riding or walking in the road. Lastly after dark carry a flash light and wear something reflective.

Drivers... please take it easy. A 7 year old on a bike *might* be right around the next corner.
