Update On The Water Quality By 1st Beach

Dean Anderson and his team of volunteers test the water quality at each of the beaches on a routine weekly basis.

On Thursday August 2nd I was notified by the East Haddam Health District that levels of bacteria were detected above acceptable levels in the area immediately adjacent to the storm drain pipe at 1st Beach. The recommended outcome was to prohibit swimming within 50 feet of the discharge area of the pipe. The testing was repeated on the following Monday and the test results were back within a normal range.

The East Haddam Water Pollution Control Authority and the Health District are in the middle of developing an action plan to identify point source pollution concerns at all of the lakes within the Town. I have requested that the WPCA and Health Department include the 1st Beach storm drain to their areas to be surveyed.

An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. While another spike of water quality test results is unlikely, a prudent practice would be to avoid swimming or fishing immediacy next to the pipe through August. Swimming within the safety lines at 1st beach will not be problem.
