First Beach Project Reconciliation

We exceeded the \$125,000 budget by \$1,775. Through prudent planning we had fortunately built in some contingency money, just not quite enough. In a project of this size we expected to have a few 'surprises' but there was a big one that we did not see coming. The old tennis courts actually had three layers of asphalt that needed to be removed and that required bigger equipment and more loads to haul away. Next, the void left by the removal of all the asphalt required more fill to be brought in to make the new tennis courts level. Lastly, we all know what has happened to the cost of a gallon of gasoline and there is a lot of petroleum in the new asphalt that was put down. We had budgeted an additional \$2,000 in higher paving expenses. The total cost of the unanticipated expenses was \$9,000.00.

That said no one has been happier than the Board with all the use that the courts have gotten this summer. Every time we see people parking and enjoying themselves at First Beach, it makes all the planning, all the meetings, all the phone calls, and your financial commitment all worth while. The crown jewel of the Association has been restored.
