Message from the President - Tim Pelton

Recap of the Annual Meeting:

The meeting was well attended as always and here are some of the highlights:

- The budgeting and final costs of the First Beach Project were reviewed and everyone is pleased with the appearance of the area and the high utilization of the tennis courts.
- Unfortunately there has been a recent increase in the amount of vandalism to boats and everyone was reminded to secure their boats when not in use and to be vigilant in monitoring suspicious activity.
- The budget for 2007 was reviewed and approved. There will be no increase in the POALH taxes for the coming year.
- Marcella Fahey has elected to step down from the Board and she was thanked for her many years of dedicated and loyal service to the community.
- There was lengthy discussion on security and unauthorized use of the First Beach parking area and the Board will develop an action plan to better control that situation.
- There was discussion of a concern regarding the appearance of an unsightly lot and the operation of a commercial business within the Association. The Board will continue its efforts to resolve the issue.
- The schedule for Lake Hayward Days was reviewed and a week long end of the season celebration is planned.

Once again this year Dick Bailey and his colleagues at his Masons' Lodge will be providing a great community service this Saturday. The Masons sponsor a great project called the Connecticut Child Identification Program to assist both you and law enforcement officials should a child be missing. With this program the Masons will collect the following information on your child: a color photograph, a dental impression, a DNA sample, a set of fingerprints, a saliva sample to assist tracking dogs, and a DVD taped interview to record the child's speech pattern, mannerisms, and important characteristics.

This service will be provided at no cost to you and your child. All the work is performed by Mason volunteers and it is part of their commitment to public service. The Masons keep none of the data and information, it is all given to the parents to maintain in a safe place (and bring on vacation) and hopefully you will never need to use it.

The plan is for the Masons to be at the lake on this Saturday in conjunction with the carnival day of Lake Hayward Days. They will set up their operation in the tennis court and will be available from 11 AM until 3 PM.

Our Posted Beach Rules

Please remember:

- 1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety & actions at all times.
- 2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
- 3. Infants must be in leak-proof diapers at all times.
- 4. Fishing within 100 ft. of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Use of boats & water craft within the swimming area or within 100 ft of rafts is prohibited.
- 6. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
- 7. There is no swimming after 11PM.
- 8. All trash & cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be disposed of.
- 9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members & their guests.
- 10. Cars parking in a beach parking area must display a POALH parking sticker or a dated guest pass.

Additional Important Beach Rules:

- 1. Fill all holes dug in the sand before leaving the beach.
- 2. Please take all personal items with you when you leave the beach do not leave toys, clothing, etc.
