## Why it's better to keep leaves and grass clippings out of lakes and streams

Our June 22nd newsletter had a very good Lake Quality Improvement Committee article summarizing our current knowledge and approach to improving our lake health. There are a number of factors that contribute to the creation of algae. These include (1) external and internal nutrients added to the lake, (2) water temperature stratification, and (3) water chemistry.

The two key nutrients are phosphorous and nitrogen. External examples of nutrient loading include discharges from storm drains, water runoff from lawns and roads, septic effluent, etc. As homeowners, we have some control over these nutrients entering the watershed, by reducing and even eliminating phosphate fertilizers, not dumping leaves and grass clippings into the lakes and streams and pumping our septic systems every 3-5 years.


The amount of phosphorous measured in the bottom waters of our lake has trended upward over the last several years. Nutrients also enter the lake internally through the decomposition process of sediment in the lake.


Water stratification occurs over the summer perature equalizes in the Fall, the layers of when the surface of the lake warms up. The warmer water is less dense then the colder water below and the two thermal layers of water simply mix together less. Sometimes when you dive into the lake or explore 8-10 feet below the surface of the lake, you can feel the difference in water temperature. This stratification lends itself to algae production. When the water tem-


warmer and cooler water mix and the internal nutrients from the bottom join the external nutrients at the top to support algae growth closer to the surface. This is called Fall turnover.


This is why homeowners are requested to dispose of grass clippings and fallen leaves off site.
