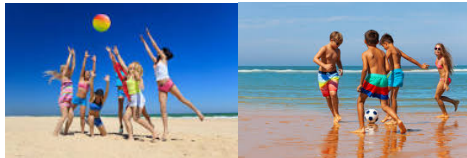

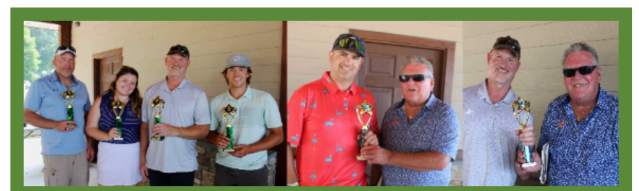


2023 Lake Hayward Open
