Geese Alert

There are 30-40 geese that are flying in and have been for the last few weeks. Now that they can fly, we can harass them. If you see them on our beaches, please take a few minutes to chase them off. If you're out on your boat, please harass them until they fly off. Splashing them with water works – they don't like to get wet. However, it is illegal to hurt them so please be careful.

For those whose dogs have been approved to move them off our beaches in the morning and early evening, please be sure your dog is leashed and wearing the red bandana.

Invasive Aquatic Weed Treatment is Scheduled for August 28, 2023

Our permit to treat was received on August 11, 2023 from CT. DEEP. We are scheduled to have the lake treated by Solitude Lake Management on Monday, August 28, 2023. There will be signs posted throughout our community a few days prior to treatment to alert residents and visitors and will remain posted for seven days after the date of treatment. Do not use the lake water for the following purposes on the day of treatment – swimming, boating, fishing, and watering livestock. Do not use the lake water until three days after treatment for drinking, cooking, and irrigation. These restrictions will also be noted on the signage to be posted throughout our community. Any unexpected changes in this treatment date will be communicated to our residents. Please remember that Solitude does use a gas-powered boat for the treatment so do not be alarmed when you see it.
